To Board of Directors of **Trent Limited**

1. We have audited the accompanying Statement of Standalone Annual Financial results of Trent Limited ("the Company") for the year ended 31st March, 2017 attached herewith, being submitted by the Company pursuant to the requirement of Regulation 33 of the SEBI (Listing Obligations and Disclosure Requirements) Regulations, 2015, as modified by Circular No. CIR/CFD/FAC /62/2016 dated 5th July, 2016.

These financial results, which are the responsibility of the Company's management and approved by the Board of Directors, have been prepared on the basis of the Standalone annual Ind AS financial statements which have been prepared in accordance with the Indian Accounting Standards specified under Section 133 of the Companies Act, 2013 read with relevant rules issued thereunder("IND AS") and other accounting principles generally accepted in India.
